Welcome to DreamBox Learning Math, a digital math program that combines a fun and engaging math learning environment with a rigorous, standards-based curriculum. DreamBox's adaptive technology integrates conceptually-based instruction with assessment, so students spend more time learning, not testing. DreamBox is **already** available to your child through your Clever and Schoology portals, and you can play all throughout the summer!

Simple Steps to Play DreamBox at Home

STEP 1: Get Familiar with DreamBox

- Play a sample lesson to see how your child learns while playing DreamBox-

- Sign up for the [Family Portal](#)

STEP 2: Engage in DreamBox with Your Child

- Login to DreamBox through [Clever](#) or **Schoology**
 - Observe how your child engages while playing a lesson
 - Discuss the weekly goal for completing lessons and how close they are to reaching their goal (DreamBox recommends at least 5 lessons/week)
- Discuss the importance of perseverance and finishing lessons even when they're tricky, and make sure to allow your child to work independently



STEP 3: Play and Monitor

- Allow your child time to complete at least 1 lesson each time they log in
- Schedule time each week for your child to engage
- Monitor your child's progress through your [Family Portal](#)
